DKG Constitutional Changes

Each state organization of the Society shall be designated by a geographical or a country name. Each chapter shall be named by the state organization. i.e. We are now the Alabama State Organization of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International.

In all membership references, change the word <u>initiated to inducted.</u>

An individual becomes a member when she pays her dues.

Adds a 4th classification of membership – Collegiate. Collegiate members will pay \$20 International dues.

Realigns the dues payment dates to coincide with the fiscal year $\underline{\text{July 1}} - \underline{\text{June 30 starting June 30, 2019.}}$

<u>Changes the name</u> of the Communications and Publicity Committee to Communications and Marketing Committee.

Amendments to the Constitution may now be made every 2 years instead of every 4.

Group Me

Madeline has set up a Beta Lambda site on GroupMe. GroupMe is a free app for a smartphone that uses text messaging to contact everyone who has signed up for a particular group. The GroupMe group for Beta Lambda was set up several months ago and Brenda has already used it to let everyone on the group know about the planning meeting that took place in August.

GroupMe can be downloaded from the App Store or Google Play. Please sign up for GroupMe so that you can start receiving messages from other members. This is a valuable resource that can enhance communication.

If members don't have a smartphone, they can access GroupMe on the web or even get the messages by text messaging.

Minutes of August Executive Board Meeting

August 6, 2018, 1 p.m.

President Brenda Johnson called the Executive Board meeting to order at 1:15 p.m. The following Beta Lambda members were present: Maria Brandt, Madeline Buchanan, Beverly Jackson, Sandra Joganic, Brenda Johnson, Beverly Lavender, Pat Long, Betsy Precise, and Jody Stewart.

Minutes for the Executive Board meeting will be included in the September newsletter to be approved at the September chapter meeting.

Madeline Buchanan and Brenda Johnson attended the Beta State One Day Officer Training on June 1 in Montgomery and gave reports on the workshop. This new format for officer training replaced District meetings.

The DKG International Convention was held July 16-20 in Austin, Texas. Reports were given by Madeline Buchanan, Pat Long, and Jody Stewart. This was a constitutional convention and changes in the constitution were discussed.

Treasurer Beverly Lavender gave the reports for April, May, June, and July. These and the August reports will be included in the September newsletter. She gave the president and finance committee chair a copy of Form 15/The DKG Society International Annual Report of Chapter Treasurer, which was submitted by the July 15 due date.

Committee reports were presented next. Finance: The chapter rules state that the finance committee will develop an annual proposed budget and present it to the membership no later than the September meeting. Treasurer Beverly Lavender stated she would prepare a list of actual income/expenses for the past year for the finance committee. Membership: New member Susan Holt was inducted at the April meeting, which was cut short due to inclement weather. Her certificate of membership will be presented at the September meeting. Pictures of our newest member and new officers will be taken at the September meeting. Chairperson Jody Stewart, the only person on this committee, discussed our membership activities for the past year. Members discussed focusing on local college students. Nominations: The duties of the nominations committee begin in the fall of 2019. Educational Excellence: Dr. Sherri Savage is the only person on the committee. Chapter Rules: Chairperson Madeline Buchanan questioned whether she could hold offices for both first vice president and parliamentarian. Communications: Chairperson Madeline Buchanan would like for another chapter member to take her place on this committee. Duties include updating the chapter website. Members discussed how often they visit our chapter website. Most members make use of the chapter newsletters more than the website. Brenda Johnson will continue preparing the chapter newsletter. Telephone/Social: Beverly Sublette will continue to contact members about meetings via email, text, or telephone. Scholarship/Grant-In-Aid: Dr. Sue Garrick presented changes to the scholarship and grant-in-aid last year, which were published in the minutes and newsletter. World Fellowship: Members discussed whether to continue the auction, which is a major source of income for our chapter. Other fundraising options were mentioned. Members decided to continue the auction. Auditing: Chairperson Sandra Joganic reported that the audit would be performed at the adjournment of today's meeting. Treasurer Beverly Lavender brought materials needed for the audit.

Members, please consider being on the Educational Excellence and Membership committees. President Brenda Johnson recommended that the first person listed alphabetically by last name for each committee be the chairperson. The chairperson would rotate each year to the next person listed alphabetically by last name.

First Vice President Madeline Buchanan discussed programs and locations for 2018-2019. Brenda Johnson attended the Gamma Kappa planning meeting on July 15 for Madeline. We will meet twice with the Gamma Kappa chapter this year. Gamma Kappa will host the April 13, 2019, meeting; the program

will be Free2Teach. Our chapter will host the joint meeting on January 12, 2019, at Brookdale; the proposed program topic is mentoring and advising college students majoring in education. A list of last year's successful chapter programs was distributed at the Beta State One Day Officer Training in June. Brenda Johnson read some program suggestions from the list. A suggestion was made to invite all former members to a homecoming/reunion meeting. Madeline will provide the 2018-2019 program information to be published in the September newsletter.

Second Vice President Jody Stewart discussed the yearbook. Brenda Johnson gave Jody a yearbook handout from the June Officer Training and the checklist from the last yearbook. Jody provided a list at the meeting for members to update their yearbook data.

The Beta Lambda president's project will be Rumpshaker, Inc., a non-profit organization founded in 2009, whose mission is to promote awareness about colorectal cancer, raise funds to fight and treat it, and provide hope to colorectal cancer survivors and those fighting the disease. Madeline Buchanan suggested that we try to schedule a program on this topic. At the Gamma Kappa Chapter planning meeting, their members discussed checking on the internet to find out what percentage of donations go to the charity as opposed to administrative costs.

Announcements: Beta State Executive Board (Fall Board) meeting is August 18 in Montgomery. Madeline Buchanan and Brenda Johnson plan to attend. All members are invited.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:15 after which we enjoyed delicious homemade refreshments.
