Such accomplishments may include those in a member's personal life or work setting. Examples may include outstanding projects in education, networking and/or community activities. Two pictures per applicant must be sent electronically with the application.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. One applicant per chapter.
 - B. Completely volunteer – no compensation of any kind – money or gifts.
 - C. All blanks in application must be neat and completed in full.
 - D. Application and picture must arrive before Midnight MST February 15, 2018.**
 - E. A one-time award in their lifetime.
 - F. **One-page** synopsis to be exact and completed in 200 words or less.
