SB 46 Stewart HB315 Williams	Reading Achievement Initiative for Scholastic Excellence Program	Tutoring program may be provided after the school day, provides for stipend for instructional personnel and students who serve as tutors
HB 49 Chaney	Employment and Curfew of Minors	Removes certain employment restrictions for minors 16 & 17 years of age; revises age at which employment restrictions apply; prohibits counties & municipalities from adopting or enforcing certain ordinances that are more stringent than state law.

HB 207 Rayner	Social Media Protection for Minors	Requires social media platforms to disclose policies & provide resources, measures, & disclaimers; authorizes social media platforms to post compliance statements on Internet homepage or user login page; prohibits schools from using or having social media platform accounts & requiring students to register, enroll, or participate in social media platforms for educational purposes.
SB 200 Gruters	Educator Certification	Requiring the Department of Education to develop and establish a method for a person holding a professional educator certificate to place a professional certificate in inactive status while the person teaches at a nonaccredited school, etc.
SB 240 Burton HB 667 McFarland	International Baccalaureate Teacher Bonuses	Revising the requirements for the calculation of additional full-time equivalent membership and certain bonuses based on International Baccalaureate examination scores of students to include students who earn equivalent scores as determined by the Department of Education, etc.
SB 250 Perry	Frazier School for Competitive Academics	Changing the name of the Florida School for Competitive Academics to the Frazer School for Competitive Academics, etc.

SB 300 Berman	Universal Free School Breakfast and Lunch Program	Requiring the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, subject to the appropriation of funds by the Legislature, to establish and operate a program to provide universal free school breakfast and lunch meals to all public school students; deleting provisions requiring school districts to implement and charge students for a breakfast program; authorizing school districts to operate free school meal programs using offsite food preparation locations, etc.
HB 313 Plasencia	Transparency for Autism-Related Services	Provides definition for term "manifests" or "onset"; requires APD to provide specified information when notifying applicant of his or her eligibility determination.
HB 323 Gossett-Seidman	Caregiving Youth	Creates Florida Caregiving Youth Task Force within DOH for specified purpose; provides for membership, meetings, & duties of task force; requires task force to submit report; requires DOE to maintain & make available to school districts comprehensive list of specified information; requires each middle & high school to have designated caregiving youth liaison; provides that caregiving youth may count hours devoted to caring for household member toward certain community service hour requirements; exempts caregiving youth from payment of certain tuition & fees.
