FOUNDATION FUND

Foundation funds are obtained from donations, bequests, gifts, and grants. The Board currently funds projects through the bequests from Lottie Skidmore (library projects), Alfreda Chalberg (general projects), and Patricia M. Ostewig (fine arts projects). The Board of Directors reserves the final option for the acceptance of a prospective charitable gift.

The income from the invested funds and designated contributions are used for stipends and for administrative expenses.

Copies of the bylaws are available from the Foundation secretary.

Grants of money from other foundations or governmental agencies become income to be used, primarily, for education projects stipends.

STIPENDS

The Foundation Fund income supports research and projects proposed by members/chapters/coordinating councils of the DKG Illinois State Organization. The programs funded are designed to improve the quality of student education in Illinois.

Applications for stipends are available from the Foundation secretary or on the State Website. Deadline dates are May 1 and November 1 for applications.

Stipends awarded by the Board of Directors vary in amount depending on the project plan submitted in the application and available funds. The Foundation has awarded 342 stipends totaling approximately \$267,531.35 to date.

Foundation supported projects are shared with DKG Illinois State Organization members through workshops, presentations and by other communications.
