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### **HEALTH CARE COVERAGE**

Those persons who already have health insurance (Medicare, Medicaid, Veterans Health Plans, or those who already have any other type of medical insurance) are unaffected by the new health care law.

Current actions in the U.S. Congress do not affect your ability to select a health care plan. Almost all of the federal money allotted to the states has already been received.

If you do not have any health care coverage the timeline for the new health insurance program is shown below.

October 1, 3013 – March 31, 2014 -- open enrollment through health care exchanges January 1, 2014 – coverage begins

To find out what plans are available in your state go to <a href="www.Healthcare.gov">www.Healthcare.gov</a>. After answering a series of questions the various plans available to you will appear. A helpline which is manned 24 hours a day can answer any questions you may have. The telephone number for the help line is <a href="1-800-318-2596">1-800-318-2596</a>. Keep in mind that the closer to January 1, the longer the wait time to get information by telephone. (Note: Give it a day or two now as they work out the glitches in the system.)

DO NOT GIVE ANY INFORMATION TO AN UNKNOWN PERSON WHO CONTACTS YOU BY PHONE ABOUT HEALTH INSURANCE. THE NEW HEALTH CARE PLAN IS THE TYPE OF SITUATION WHICH BRINGS OUT THE SCAM ARTISTS IN FORCE. DEAL ONLY WITH THE GOVERNMENT WEB SITE OR THE PERSONEL AT THE GOVERNMENT TELEPHONE NUMBER (1-800-318-2596) WHEN YOU INITIATE THE CALL.

### **SAVING ON MEDICARE PART D**

There is a government web site which can be used to save money on Medicare Part D Prescription Drugs. To utilize this source go to <a href="https://www.medicare.gov/find-a-plan/questions/home.aspx">https://www.medicare.gov/find-a-plan/questions/home.aspx</a>, I recommend you use the "General Search" option, Before you start you should have a list of prescription drugs you are taking. This should be those you are taking for a long period of time on a regular basis for example blood pressure pills, arthritis drugs, diabetic medications, thyroid medication, acid reflux prescriptions, etc. You need to check this site every year as plans can change costs for a specific drug. Also some prescription drugs become available in generic form which is much cheaper than getting a brand name drug. The availability of generic drugs is part of the reason why changes in the cost of various prescriptions take place each year. Editor's note: I saved \$1,000 this year by using the information obtained from this site.
