RAPE IN THE MILITARY

The National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2014 (HR 3304ENR) passed by both the House and the Senate and signed by the President on December 26, 2013 changes the way in which rape in the military is to be handled. The bill would strip commanders of their ability to overturn or modify sentences handed down by judges and/or juries. CNN reported passage of the bill which would establish minimum sentencing guidelines and would require that sexual offenses be included in military personnel records. The portion of the bill dealing with sexual assault is "TITLE XVII-SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION AND RESPONSE AND RELATED REFORMS." This is a very long bill and the section dealing with sexual assault is not even mentioned in the abstract of the legislation.

POSTAGE RATE CHANGE

Starting on January 26, 2014 the cost of a stamp for a letter weighing less than 1 ounce will go from \$0.46 to \$0.49. This is about a 6.5% increase in price. Other postage rates will change at that time also. For a complete listing of postal rates go to www.usps.com. You can buy "forever" stamps at the current rate, and they will be good for whatever the price of a first class letter-sized item is in the future. For example, a 100 roll of forever stamps will cost \$46 on January 25, 2014, but it will cost \$49 on January 26, 2014.
