Notification

Each applicant will be notified by February 15 as to the status of her selection.

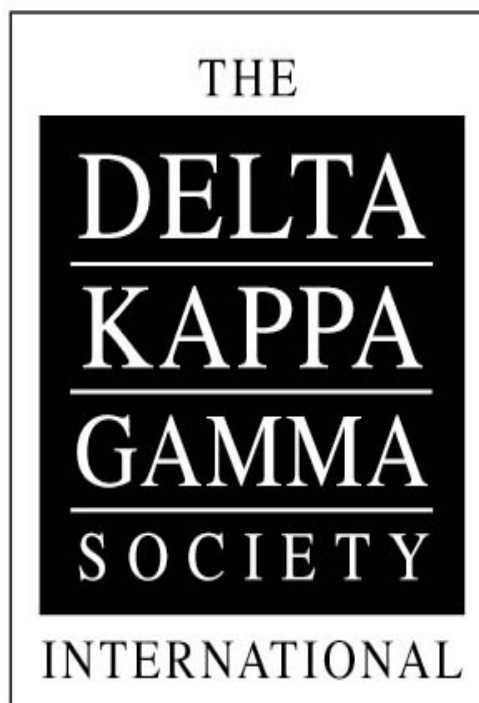
Selected applicants must send written notice of their acceptance to the State Scholarships Chair by March 1.

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International offers thirty \$6,000 scholarships annually to active members who have completed a master's degree or equivalent and have been accepted and enrolled in a graduate program (preferably pursuing a doctoral degree). An applicant must have been a member for three years, must provide evidence of active participation and leadership in Delta Kappa Gamma, and may not have received an International Scholarship previously.

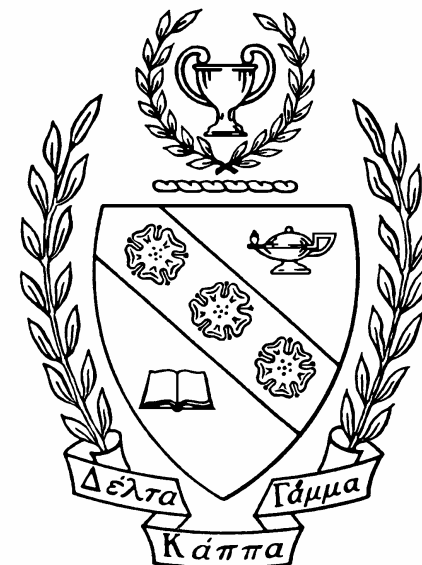

SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL STUDY STIPEND PROGRAM

The program was first instituted in 1929 when the Delta Kappa Gamma Society was founded in Austin, Texas. In the original constitution, an annual scholarship fee of one dollar per member was required. Although some changes have occurred, the basic purpose remains the same today: To provide women educators with financial support to develop skills which promote professional and personal growth.

Lambda State offers stipends to active members based upon the availability of funds in the program. Funding is provided by members' and chapters' contributions as well as interest in the fund. These have been presented in memory and honor of the following deceased state presidents and/or founders:

The number and amounts of stipends are recommended to the Executive Board at the state convention. Recipients will be judged on Society participation, recommendations and personal essay.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for a special study stipend the applicant must meet the basic criteria as follows:

- **Prior to the application deadline, an applicant for a special study stipend shall have completed three (3) years of membership in Lambda State.**
- **Provide evidence of active participation and leadership in the Society.**
- **Complete an application form with a reference from the chapter president or immediate past president.**
- **Must reach the State Scholarships Chair postmarked by January 10.**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **Special study stipends shall be awarded to develop skills which promote professional and personal growth.**
- **The educational experience, for which the special study stipends are awarded, shall have been taken between January and December 31 the year preceding the awarding (1-1-11 to 12-31-11).**
- **The applicant agrees to remain an active member of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International.**
- **The applicant agrees to share information with Delta Kappa Gamma members.**
- **Winners are encouraged to attend the state convention.**
- **The recipient must be willing to share information at a Delta Kappa Gamma function.**
