Preparing for the electronic delivery of Eta State NEWS

The Eta State Executive Committee has approved the proposal to begin planning for the electronic delivery of *Eta State News* to members who are willing to receive their newsletters by that method. Electronic delivery will not begin until the next biennium.

Chapters should designate **one person** to compile the names, ID numbers, and email addresses for all the members of the chapter **who are willing** to receive their newsletters online. This list should be sent to **Linda Davenport at International Headquarters** at lindad@dkg.org. The headquarters staff requests that this information be sent by chapters rather than by individuals.

“The important thing to remember is that one chapter member is to batch the names and send them all to International at one time. Linda Davenport stressed that all the names, ID #'s, and email addresses for a chapter should be sent together. I'm sure she will accept additional names (also batched) at a later time period as new members are received or should other members later decide to get their newsletters electronically. What she does not want is for names to trickle in one at a time and from different people in the chapter.” Carroll Harrell
