

ETA STATE GOLDEN KEY AWARD



ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS AND GENERAL GUIDELINES

The Eta State Golden Key Award honors Delta Kappa Gamma members who have made significant contributions to Delta Kappa Gamma at various levels of the Society. One member from each of the eleven (11) regions will be honored at the Eta State Convention, if the nominees meet the standards for this award. Recipients must be active members of Delta Kappa Gamma in Eta State for at least 7 years. No current elected state officer, appointed personnel, past Eta State president, or current member of the awards committee are eligible. Recipients must uphold the principles and purposes of Delta Kappa Gamma and demonstrate their commitment to Delta Kappa Gamma by being involved in local and state initiatives.

No member may receive this award more than once. Members nominated in previous years, but not selected may have their names resubmitted. Names of nominees shall remain anonymous. Each chapter can nominate one member annually.

Special emphasis is directed toward Delta Kappa Gamma participation. Community involvement, involvement in other organizations and involvement in education in general are important in the selection process as to the extent that these activities further the purposes of the Society. It is not a requirement that a nominee must have attended other Society events such as SE Regional or an International Convention, but this information can be included in the DKG participation. Completed nomination forms, along with a picture of the nominee, must be postmarked or emailed no later than March 1 to be considered. Forms postmarked or emailed after March 1 will not be considered for the current year but may be submitted at a later date.

Recipients of the Eta State Golden Key Award will be notified by March 30.
