Take the teaching moments. The children will ask about a word. Even at the K level, start talking to them about "combinations" and rules such as "ci, ce, and cy make 'c' say 's'." Do not wait for the curriculum to "teach" it. The kids will pick it up if they are exposed to it. I have great readers and writers in K because I do not hold back in that teaching moment.
