

## ALPHA RHO STATE AWARDS

In 2003 Dr. Bobbie Nelson, president of Alpha Rho State, requested an Ad Hoc committee to create awards that could be conferred on chapters for their participation in the Society's business through communication. In 2004 President Madaline Lapp continued the committee to include individual members for their participation in the Society's business through Alpha Rho state, through Oregon education or in their communities. These awards are announced and presented at the annual state convention.

### **ROSETTE AWARD**

1. A copy of the chapter program booklet/yearbook sent by **December 1** to each of the following: the State President, the State Program Chair, and the chapter's District Coordinator.
2. Chapter President's report sent by **February 1** to the State President.
3. Four chapter newsletters and the chapter brochure sent by **March 1** to the Communications Chair.

### **THE ORDER OF THE ROSE AWARD**

1. Complete the Rosette Award requirements
2. Initiate \_\_\_ members between **April 1** of the year preceding the last state convention and **April 1** of the current state convention, according to the following parameters:

Small Chapter (30 or less members)	initiate	<u>at least 3 new members</u>
Medium Chapter (31-50 members)	initiate	<u>at least 4 new members</u>
Large Chapter (51 or more members)	initiate	<u>at least 5 new members</u>

1. A nomination letter signed by a chapter president detailing why the chapter feels this person deserves the particular award sent to the Awards Chair no later than **March 15**.

The nominations will be reviewed and decided upon by a committee appointed by the State President. This committee will be composed of past award winners and/or members of the State Executive Committee. The committee will make all decisions as to whether or not an award is given, and to whom. The committee is given the discretion of creating new awards and revising award requirements, as needed. The state president is not eligible for an achievement award during her term of office.
