To be eligible a woman must:

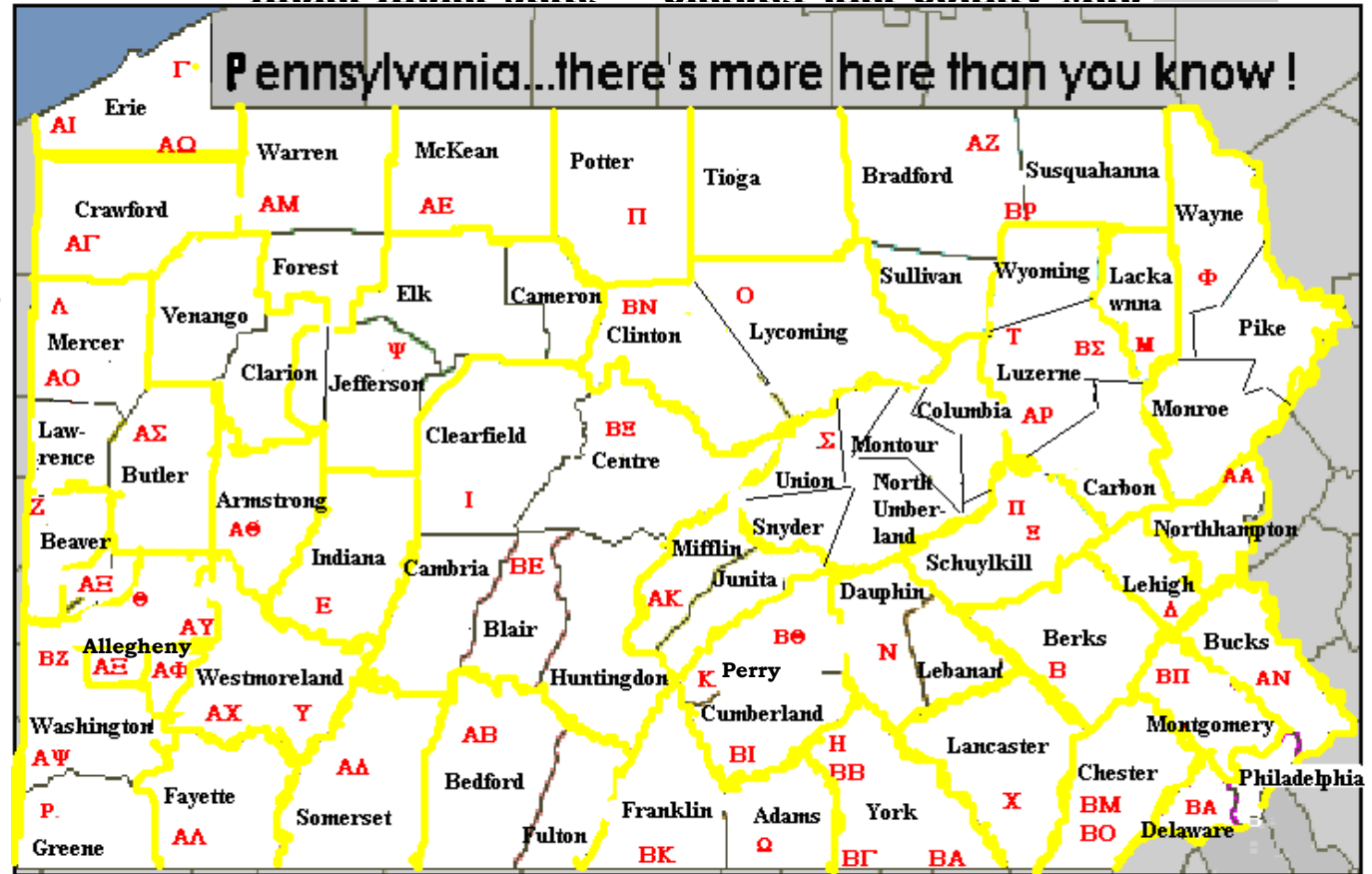
Have three or more years in educational work and employment in the profession at time of consideration.
