

7.5 The chapter's recording secretary shall maintain a complete record of all membership in Alpha

Gamma Chapter including memberships that are terminated. The record shall include the reason, non-payment of dues and fees, resignation, or death, and date of termination. The chapter shall file letters of resignation.

The Rules Committee also suggested that we add something to acknowledge transfers. A new 7.8 could be added to read as follows:

7.8 A member in good standing may transfer from one chapter to another upon notification to Society Headquarters.

Please be prepared to vote on these changes at the December meeting.

Please plan to elect three (3) members to the Nominations Committee during the Christmas meeting.

The Christmas meeting is scheduled for December 11, 2012, 6 PM at the Welcome Center. We will happily initiate our newest members, enjoy dinner together, and be inspired by beautiful music of the season. Perhaps we would like to use the opportunity to assist those less fortunate.
