Strawberry Butter

1/2 cup butter (1 cube), softened

1/2 cup powdered sugar

3-4 strawberries

- . Chop strawberries until very small. Can be done through a <u>mini food</u> <u>processor</u> for several pulses.
- . In a separate bowl, blend together the softened butter and powdered sugar.
- Add about 3/4 of the mashed strawberries and mix to combine. Determine at that point if you'd like to add the remaining strawberries
 - Store in a closed jar or container in the fridge. Recipe yields <u>two 4-oz jars</u> of strawberry butter.
