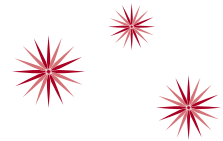

White Bean and Chicken Chili

2 (15 oz.) cans white beans, rinsed and drained
4 cups low-sodium chicken broth
1 tablespoon vegetable oil
2 chicken breasts
1 teaspoon salt and black pepper
2 onions, chopped
4 cloves garlic, chopped
2 (4 oz.) cans green chilies, drained
1 cup water
1 tablespoon ground cumin

Preparation: Place beans and broth in a slow cooker. Cook on high until beans are tender, Warm oil in skillet over medium-high heat. Sprinkle chicken with salt and pepper. Cook until brown, Add onions and garlic; cook until softened, Add onion mixture, chilies, 1 cup water and cumin to slow cooker. Stir; add chicken. Cook on low for 6 hours, stirring twice. Serve with sour cream and cornbread.
