To receive messages via text, text to the phone number 81010 (put 81010 in the "To" box) and @jensisoud as the message. Or to receive messages via email, send an email to jensisoud@mail.remind.com. You can leave the subject blank. You need to do one or the other or both. Jensi sends out notices or reminds to the chapter concerning items that do not have time to make it to THE INFORMER, i.e. illness, births, deaths. Stay informed; sign up.

Remind is a free, safe, and simple messaging tool that helps teachers share important updates and remainders with students and parents. It is a wonderful classroom tool as well as for DKG. Susie Westbrook's Grape Salad

Total Time: 30 min

Prep: 15 min Inactive:15 min Yield: 12 servings

Level: Easy

Ingredients

2 pounds seedless green grapes

2 pounds seedless purple grapes

One 8-ounce package cream cheese, room temperature

One 8-ounce container sour cream

1/2 cup granulated sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1/2 cup brown sugar, firmly packed

1/2 cup pecans, finely chopped

Directions

Wash the grapes and dry thoroughly with paper towels. Put the dry grapes in a 9-by-13-inch baking dish. In a bowl, combine the cream cheese, sour cream, granulated sugar and vanilla. Mix well using an electric mixer. Pour this mixture over the grapes and toss together until all the grapes are coated. Chill in the refrigerator.

Just before serving, sprinkle with the brown sugar and pecans.
