- \* Inspiration was given by Laurie Richardson
- \* 40 and 50 year members were honored with pins. 3 members celebrated 53 years and 4 members celebrated 40 years.
- \* Reports on State Convention and Regional Conference. Sharon reported that Alpha Phi received certificates at Xi State for: 2013 Strategic Action Plan, Newsletter, Positive Membership Growth, Highest Honors for Chapter Yearbook, and Silver Chapter Excellence Award. Sharon reported on Xi State and gave an overview of highlights.
- \* Jensi reported on the Regional Conference in Orlando at Gaylord Palms. The speakers spoke on women's courage. Barbara N., Lin, Sharon, and Jensi attended.
- \* 2014 conference will be in Indianapolis.
- \* Minutes were approved and seconded.
