

## CHAPTER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

### Standard for eligibility

1. Each member of Epsilon Kappa will be considered for the Chapter Achievement Award except for members of the executive board for the current biennium.
2. Nominees shall have a good attendance record at chapter meetings.
3. This award will be based on contributions made to Epsilon Kappa.
  - a. Although the award is for outstanding service to Epsilon Kappa, services to the Society at large and to other professional organizations, civic and community may be noted.
  - b. Evidence of personal growth as marked by continued efforts to advance professional standards will be considered.
  - c. Evidence of personal qualities exemplifying the highest standards of a professional educator and a worthy Delta Kappa Gamma member will be noted.

### Procedures

1. Nominations will be accepted from the membership by March 1 of each even numbered year. A nomination form will be made available to chapter members beginning in January of the award year.
2. The Awards Committee shall do the following:
  - a. Complete an information sheet on each nominee.
  - b. Distribute a copy of the information sheet to each member of the Awards Committee and the executive board.
  - c. Selection will be made by a joint vote of the executive board and the Awards Committee.
  - d. Collect and count the ballots.
  - e. Announce the recipient at the April brunch.
3. These guidelines will be reviewed once each biennium by the Awards Committee and any changes must be approved by the executive board.

### The Award

The rose pin-guard shall be presented to each recipient.
